This walk may be short in distance, but it offers you an interesting 500 m along the forest of Bon-Secours. You will follow sloping forest paths that are sometimes barely marked and by means of explanatory signs you will discover the history of the beech grove. This beech grove has suffered over the years, but is coming to life again: witness it yourself and learn more about the basic principles of forest management.

Climbing the Mont de Maintvault, among trees of hundred year old, is like travelling back in time. Halfway the slope towers an 18th century Calvary. The inhabitants of the village have called it "Moïse", after one of the stone characters. A legends tells that after a complete tour of the statues one can expect an abundant harvest, a husband, or children. Next to its undeniable interesting heritage, this country walk combines quietness and symbiosis with nature. Wear appropriate walking shoes to fully enjoy this walk.

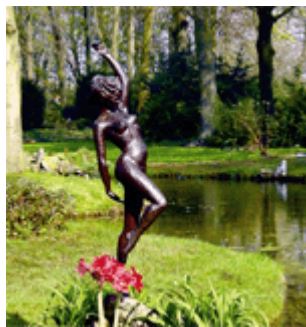

This nice 3,5 km trail allows you to get to know different indigenous species while walking on the other side of the first Gaume cuesta. Along the entire trail the indigenous trees are identified by an orange dot painted at the base of their trunk and their name is indicated on a plaque. The educational walk of the indigenous trees is a kind of counterpart of the arboretum of Virton that focuses on exotic species.

Opened in 1996, this arboretum, as its name suggests, offers an original approach. Unlike traditional arboretums, this is not a single site with many tree species brought together. Instead, 60 or 70 listed species can be discovered through a walk through the village streets, three walks in the woods and along a path linking the Pont Saint-Nicolas and the landing stage along the banks of the Semois. This nature walk provides an opportunity to observe the different growth pattern of trees in the same species growing in clumps or standing alone.

### THE FAGNES AND LAKES TRAIL

Malmedy is the departure point of this trail. Not far from Bévercé, the itinerary progressively meanders and climbs. You arrive at the station of Mont-RIGI. Close to the crossroads there is a welcoming and information centre. You reach the Baraque Michel (675 m). At the Gileppe dam, you can take the tour of the lake on foot or by mountain bike. It's really extraordinary. The road goes to Eupen, pay it a visit and continue towards Montjoie. After about 9 km the trail reaches Elsenborn and the Robertville dam, and Nidrum, a village that lightly slopes towards Warche and Bütgenbach and its lake. After the Steinbach crossroads, you will enter the Amblève valley. Born and Falise bring you back to Malmedy.

### LA FAGNE DE POLLEUR

The perfect walk to show children the environment of the Fagnes. This walk goes mostly over duckboards. It covers more than 2,5 km in the heart of the reserve, interrupted with educational panels. A walk that is accessible with strollers. A small variant towards the bridge of Bosfagne extends the walk by 2 km. Departure from the Mont Rigi.

### LA GRANDE TRAVERSEE DES FAGNES

A bit further along from the Nature Centre of Botrange, after having crossed the national road we immediately find a path. Past the village of Sourbrodt, the Pont de Bosfagne (bridge) is the point of departure for numerous walks. After a slope, we go into this sanctuary where the Walloon Fagne meets the Cléfaye Fagne. We then descend towards the "Herzogenhügel", where we find a complete change of scenery. Down in the valley we meet up with la Helle. To get to the Haus Ternell we cross a section of the Hertogenwald. There you have 2 options waiting: you continue the itinerary (40 km in total) or you return the same way you came.

**Walk type:** BIKE RIDE

**Length of the trail:** 16 km.

### Comment:

Point of departure is on the car park of the Nature Centre of Botrange. The path is located opposite the road. This 16,5 km walk takes you along to the Haus Ternell. It can take up to a day, with a long slope when you return. We recommend you to use a mountain bike or a trekking bike, because some of the sections are metalled or covered with mud.

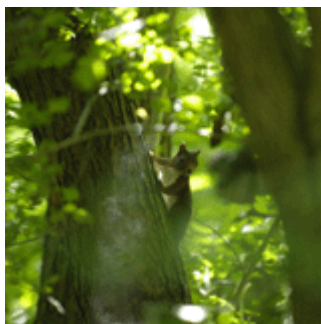

## PROMENADE : OTTIGNIES - LOUVAIN-LA-NEUVE

Departure at the welcoming pavilion. Walk along the lake at the north side towards the Fortin bridge. Go along the Ry-Angon via the chemin du Lac. At the crossing of the chemin des Massettes, take the chemin du Lac again and go up to the Martin bridge. Continue the chemin du Lac and go left at the crossing, in the chemin des Pouilots and continue via the path of the Molinegnes and the Hollow of the Roitelets. At the crossing, take the chemin des Sarts, go right on the path of the broken tree (slopes for +/- 30 m). Descent the hollow of la Sablière (slopes for +/- 60 m) towards the Biches bridge. Don't take the sentier de la Baronne because it ends in a staircase! Take a right towards the Fortin bridge and walk along the lake at the south side to the welcoming pavilion and the cafeteria.

**Walk type:** PROMENADE

**Length of the trail:** 4 km.

**Comment:**

Access via the N4 exit towards the N 233 (direction Bruyères) or via the N 35 (exit Bois des Rêves). The departure point is on the car park of the Provincial Estate of the Bois des Rêves. At the entrance of the site, at 130 m from here, there is a cafeteria/reception with toilets.

The trail is about 3.8 km long. Duration +/- 1 h (open all year round). Accompaniment is required for some slopes.

Remark on accessibility: This walk has been done in an electrical wheelchair, with dry weather and good tyres.

There are dozens of other walks accessible across Wallonia.

WALK OF THE LEGENDS

Two puppet players, S. Collard and F. Pierret started in 1992 with the walk of the legends. This 2 km walk on the theme of legends starts at "l'Atelier Pinocchio", in the heart of the village of Laforêt, with the fresco of the "Chasseur sauvage" (wild hunter) realised by Maurice Mergny. This 1 hour walk goes over stony paths and forest ways. It is accessible to strollers and wheelchairs. During this walk you will discover some legendary characters such as the Dame Blanche (white lady), the Verbouc, the nutons (dwarfs), the werewolf and many others. At the end of the trail, you'll find a picnic area at the station named "Mawhotte".

## PROMENADE A SERAING

On foot - easy

This walk is a first introduction to the forest. Thanks to the short and simple trail this walk is perfect for children. The name Seraing calls up greyness, fire and cokes, but it is mostly a vast green area of 1200 ha, from the forest of la Vecquée to the ones of Saint-Jean.

This walk will soon make you forget all about the bit city. Silence reigns here. The green giants (beeches and oaks) accompany you during your walk, which is perfect for families (with strollers). The roads are wide and straight: you will walk across a magnificent alley of beeches, called "drève" in Walloon.

**Walk type:** PROMENADE

**Length of the trail:** 5 km.

**Comment:**

Access by the Route du Condroz. At the crossroads of Plainevaux, follow the N683 to Seraing. Turn left after 2 kilometres in direction of 'Hôpital de l'Abbaye'.

The departure point is at the edge of the wood, where the roads of Rotheux and Bonnelles join (rotunda). Parking area. The signs for the 4,5 km trail are at the entrance of the forest of la Vecquée, follow the blue rectangles.

**FOREST TRAIL OF BELOEIL  
DISCOVER**

The Mer de Sable: in the heart of the forest of Stambruges, it offers walkers peaceful paths, welcoming pavilions and a fitness trail.

The Fontaine Bouillante: This geological phenomenon is the result of a rift in the soil which allows water to spout up and bubble up at the surface.

The Chapel of Erconpuch: Close to the Mer de Sable you'll see a chapel dedicated to Notre-Dame du Buisson.

The Ottée des fées: The legends goes that at nightfall, the Stambruges women came to drop off their dirty laundry and food there. During the night, the fairies washed and ironed the clothes. The morning after the women came back to pick them up.

**Walk type:** MOUNTAIN BIKE RIDE

**Length of the trail:** 20 km.

**Comment:**

Advice of the hiker:

The three trail, of 10, 15 and 20 km are accessible to everyone and go mainly through the forest with some sections along the canal and around the "Mer de Sable". A varied trail that is ideal for mountain bikers.

Walkers can use the welcoming pavilions with barbecue and playground on reservation.

## PROMENADE SAINT-HUBERT

On foot - difficult.

The walk of the Abanages follows an entirely wooded trail. During this walk you will enjoy the forest landscapes and the biological diversity. We start the walk at the top of the Doneuse valley. Its slopes and bottom are partly made up out of very humid ground. Then we go into the high beech grove forest, and continue down to the valley and up to the hills of the Masblette valley. Finally, the trail takes you to the resinous plateau and takes you back to the starting point.

**Walk type:** PROMENADE

**Length of the trail:** 20 km.

- Walk of les Abanages (itinerary n°3) - 9,8 km - duration 3 h - Green rectangle.

- Walk of Bilaude (itinerary n°4) - 20 km - Blue rectangle.

Departure close to the welcoming area (barbecue) with car parks, ponds and children's games. The trail mainly goes through forest. You can discover various tree species and blossoming roadsides. First, you take the former railway line 109, future "RAVEL". Then, you return to the departure point by following a part of the charming little brook of the Ry de Fromont.

**Walk type:** HORSE RIDING**Comment:**

Access via the N53 Beaumont-Chimay. Follow the sign "Forêt domaniale", car park at the Ry de Fromont that is the departure of the walk.

Three possible distances: 2.8 km: yellow rectangle; 5 km: red triangle; 11,5 km (duration 3h30): blue triangle.
